We have set up Google classroom for you to use in case your child's whole class bubble has to isolate for any reason. The nursery and reception classes will continue to communicate with you via tapestry.



What is Google Classroom?

Google Classroom is a web-based learning environment. When logged into Google Classroom, students can collaborate with their peers and teachers. Google Classroom offers a digital safe space for students to view class tasks, access learning materials, view posted assignments, and turn in completed work.

We would suggest that after accessing your child's classroom, you and your child familiarise yourself with the platform together. This is where teachers will set work and send messages within the class stream. There will be a range of activities and 'assignments' posted and some of the tasks can be uploaded/completed online for the teacher to view.
