In the event that during the period specified for attendance at worship the church has been closed for public worship and has not provided alternative premises for that worship, the requirements of these [admissions] arrangements in relation to attendance will only apply to the period when the church or alternative premises have been available for public worship.

Please remember that you cannot apply for a place at any other school by using this form. This form should be returned to the school office by the date stated in the covering letter. As well as this form, you must also complete and return the Local Authority’s Common Application Form to North Yorkshire County Council.
